## **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO SERVE ON THE LEVY ON TECHNICAL DEVICES FUND COMMITTEE**

The Companies and Intellectual Property Authority (CIPA), is a parastatal established to promote and enable the full protection of the rights of investors and right holders obtained under the Companies Act, the Registration of Business Names Act, the Industrial Property Act, and the Copyright and Neighboring Rights Act.

Section 35G of the Copyright and Neighbouring Rights Act provides for a levy to be imposed on imported and locally manufactured technical devices capable of reproducing copyright protected works. Collected funds are deposited into the Levy on Technical Devices Fund (LTDF), whose objective is to promote Bo-tswana's creative industries. The Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI) is the Accounting Officer of the Fund while the Copyright Department at CIPA serves as the Secretariat.

# On behalf of the Accounting Officer, CIPA announces that two (2) opportunities exist for dynamic individuals with a background in visual arts and drama & theatre to serve in the LTDF Committee.

## Main purpose of the Committee

The responsibilities of the LTDF Committee include issuing open calls, evaluating project proposals, and monitoring project implementation. Therefore, Committee Members are expected to participate in meetings and activities of the Committee.

## Key responsibilities

As part of the Committee, the Member shall contribute to the work of the Committee and participate in the:

- a. activities and meetings of the LTDF Committee;
- b. development and adoption of guidelines and tools for awarding grants;
- c. evaluation, selection and approval of project proposals to be funded;
- d. monitoring of implementation of funded projects through the Secretariat;
- e. ensuring that the Fund is audited in accordance with international auditing standards;
- f. deliberation of all matters within the mandate of the Committee; and
- g. performing any other duties that may be assigned by the Accounting Officer.
- h. Committee Members are expected to comply with policies contained in the Handbook for the Administration of the LTDF. Committee members are not eligible to apply for funding during their tenure and twelve (12) months thereafter.

#### Qualifications, experience and knowledge required

- Interested individuals must:
  - a. be a citizen of Botswana;
  - b. have at least a degree with at least five (5) years' experience in
    i. Visual Arts (painting, sculpting, photography etc.)
    ii. Drama & theatre
  - c. a diploma and seven years of experience may be accepted in the place of a degree.

Additional experience and understanding of the creative industry is an added advantage.
